COVID -19 SAFER PLAY 2020-2021 GUIDELINES

Players will be required to comply with the following guidelines for all match play participation during the 2020-2021 league season or unless otherwise revised. Please print a copy for your records and have with you during match play. Captains are to ensure that players have read and understand these guidelines prior to participation.

- All players are encouraged to seek advice regarding their individual risks from a medical professional.
- Players may be required to abide by additional rules and regulations enforced by hosting club.
- Clean and sanitize tennis equipment and personal items after play.
- Minimize carpooling. LCWTL recommends visiting players do not carpool or limit to playing partners only while wearing masks.
- Players should practice good hygiene and sanitize frequently before, during and after match play. Players should carry their own individual sanitizer. Players should sanitize before and after use of facility restrooms.
- No non-playing traveling team players or traveling spectators allowed. Home team spectators are strongly discouraged as well.
- Masks shall be worn before and after matches while in vicinity of courts.
- Players are to properly distance during change over and set breaks.
- Traveling players may bring folding chairs to be placed within proximity to home bench to allow for proper distancing during change overs and set breaks. This must be approved by home club to avoid any on court hazard.
- All players should bring their own cups, beverage of choice, extra water, and their own snacks. Home teams will not provide snack baskets. Reduce the use of on court water dispensers.
- Bags should be placed accordingly to avoid close contact to other players. Placement shall be a minimum of 6 ft. apart while not creating an on-court hazard or distraction.
- Home club will provide (1) can of new balls. Players who wish to bring additional balls may do so as long as they are new upon arrival. Marking of balls is permissible.
- One player from each team is responsible for recording match score. Players should carry pen and paper in the event score boards are not available or restricted.
- Captains will arrive on court with (2) copies of line up sheets. These sheets shall be exchanged in accordance with rules prior to match. Captains will complete score sheets for all matches while wearing masks and keeping a 6 ft. distance. Captains will verbally agree to match scores and will keep both sheets for their records. No signature will be required therefore it is imperative there is a mutual verbal agreement before leaving premises.
